

Pastor's Notes

Normally one incidence of a thing is insufficient for us to derive important lessons. This is not so in the life of Jesus; one incident from his life and work and we have a source of truth that is never spent. Such is the wedding feast of Cana. We have only this one story of Jesus attending a wedding and yet this story is a story whose meaning can never be fully understood.

In this story Jesus blesses a young couple with wine, but not just ordinary wine, but the best wine, and not only the best wine, but plenty of it, and not only plenty of wine, but wine at no cost, and not only wine at no cost, but wine that brings joy to the heart and to the soul. In blessing this marriage, we know Jesus blesses all true marriages. In wanting the best for this couple, we know that Jesus wants the best for all couples.



Jesus' blessing of this couple at Cana helps us to understand the first reading where God through Isaiah promises to marry us and to rejoice over us. This promise of marriage is the promise of a profoundly close relationship and intimacy between God and each person, that tells us who we are, i.e., the Beloved of God, but also, also answers the deepest desires and needs of our heart and of our lives.

As Jesus wished to richly bless the couple of Cana, so Jesus wishes to richly bless us who are united to Him in marriage.

Rides to Church

We are finding as each year goes by we have more parishioners requiring rides to Mass. Married outside the Church?

Did you know that Catholics are bound by the Form of Marriage? This means that for a Catholic's marriage to be valid it must take place before a priest (Bishop or Deacon) and two witnesses. So, it is not the location that is of importance but those three people plus the couple. One can receive a Dispensation from Form if there is a serious reason to be married before someone else (eg. family friend of the other party perhaps who is a minister in another church) but even in this case there is a need to prepare for the wedding with a priest who will request the dispensation for you.

If you are in a situation where your marriage is not presently recognized by the Church either because you were not aware of this church law or because of a previous marriage that you think prevents you from a church wedding, perhaps have a chat with your parish priest or connect with Louis Melendez at the Diocesan Marriage Office at 250-479-1331 or
