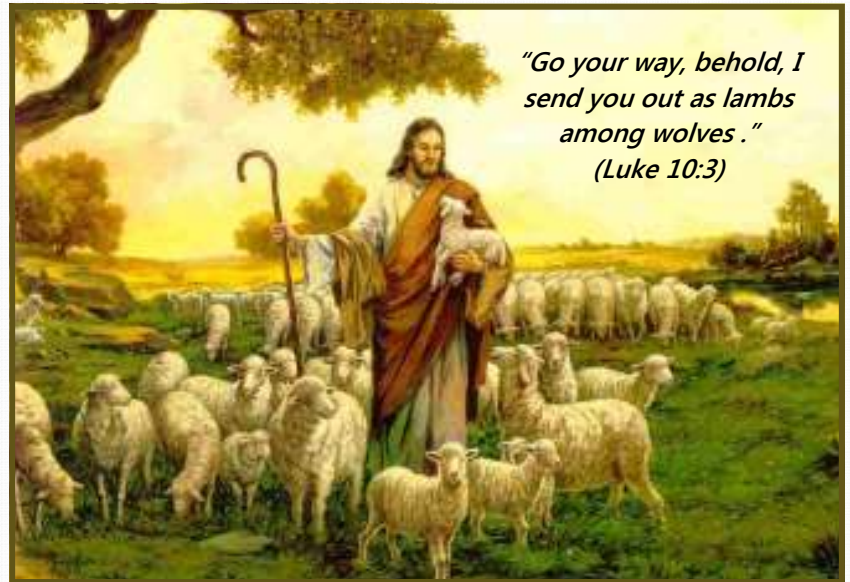

## **The Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**July 6th—July 21st, 2019**



**Jesus appointed, instructed and sent seventy-two disciples to proclaim the kingdom of God. With his authority, they were able to spread the Gospel message, and it continues today. For we, too, are called, appointed, instructed and sent with authority. We are sent to engage the world and proclaim the kingdom. Like the early disciples, we are not sent alone: we have the Church as mother, and each other as co-travellers on the journey.**

**Pray, Read, Discuss for This Week**

**Isaiah 66.10-14, Galatians 6.14-18; Luke 10.1-12, 17-20**

***"The Lord sends labourers to proclaim the kingdom."***

***Pastor's Notes:***

Paul's words to the Galatians set a standard for us today. In his letter to the Galatians, Paul writes, "May I never boast of anything except the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world." This expressed desire takes the form of a prayer, a prayer each of us should make our own. As a priest, I find it enormously distressing when assisting families in funeral preparations, to hear enormous pride in the deceased's multiple accomplishments, and hear no expression whatever of the meaning of the deceased's faith or life in Christ. The family's emphasis on the person's accomplishments is all wrong. The focus is all wrong. The meaning as given is ultimately meaningless.

"May I never boast of anything except the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ." All things in our lives must be secondary to the Cross, and all things in our lives must take their meaning from the Cross of Christ. "...by which the world has been crucified to me..." When I hear the life of the a deceased Catholic defined in secular terms, I am always greatly saddened. In light of the Cross, such a description is so impoverished.

"...and I [have been crucified] to the world." God grants us many good things in this world. All are true blessings, but all are passing, save and except they are "remembered", "received", "understood", in and through the Cross. Alone, without God's continued presence in them, such blessings are useless idols - idols which pass away. Everything good thing must be surrendered at the Cross and offered back to the Father, in union with the sacrifice of Christ.

This is our life; this is the spiritual life of a Christian; this should be our daily and hourly practice and experience. United to Christ we become both the priest and the sacrifice; all the action of our lives takes place at and through the Cross. It becomes the saving event of history and of our lives. Our respective obituaries should read: "May [it be that] I never boast[ed] of anything except the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the world ha[d] been crucified to me, and I to the world."

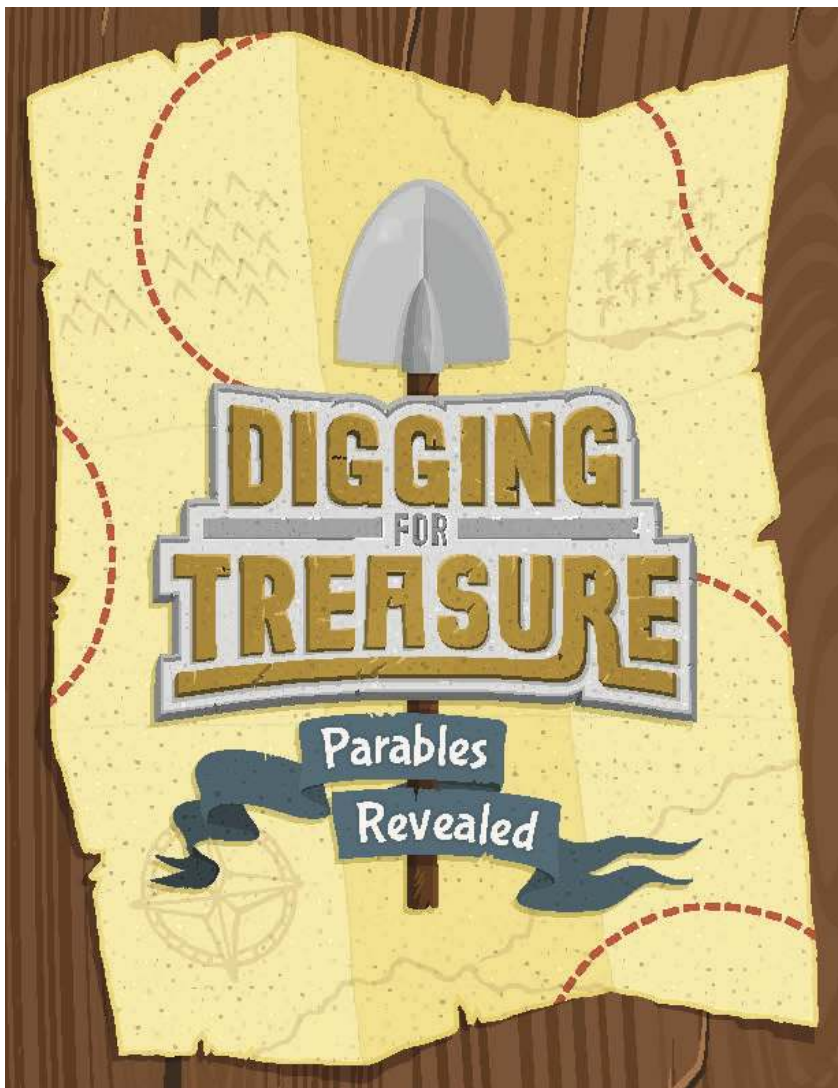
